Seconds Save Lives—Weak Signals Steal Critical Time.



! EVERY SECOND COUNTS

Do alerts reach every classroom, teacher, and administrator every time?

It doesn't matter if it is a medical emergency, an active shooter, or a fire.

A dropped call. A delayed alert. A message that never sends.

These are all barriers to a fast response.

When your signal is weak, your school is vulnerable.



COMMUNICATION IS KEY

Has your school tested emergency radio coverage inside the building?

Police, Fire, and EMS require coverage everywhere to do their jobs.

Everyone deserves to feel safe and confident that help will arrive quickly.

Every first responder needs to be heard—clearly and instantly.

- Speak up about communication gaps—your frontline experience is essential to driving change.
- Partner with parents and local leaders to advocate for safer, more responsive systems.
- Document and share near-miss incidents to highlight the urgency and need for reform.

Why You Should Care

When schools can't reach help, lives are at risk—and the gaps aren't just technical, they're systemic.

One delayed call is one too many, especially when your youngest constituents are depending on it for safety.

Every child deserves a secure learning environment. Let's make sure no call for help goes unheard.

- Champion the parents and educators that are working to make a difference in school safety.
- Treat school safety as a nonpartisan priority—because every child's life is worth the call.
- Support funding and policy that prioritizes reliable school communication infrastructure.
